Players Guidelines

Welcome to the 2012/2013 ENYC basketball season. It is a pleasure for ENYC to have you as a participant in the basketball league where you play for fun.

As with any organization that you participate in there are some basic guidelines that ENYC requests you follow and they are the following:

1. That you pledge to yourself, your teammates and your coaches to have fun
2. That you adhere to the concepts of good sportsmanship, and courtesy and respect to others
3. That you listen to the instructions of your coaches
4. That you respect and listen to any and all calls made by the referees
5. That you play fairly at all times
6. That you do not curse, smear or perform any hand gestures directed to another individual that can be viewed as a negative outburst. Failure to follow this guideline will result in a one (1) game suspension.
7. That you do not fight during practices, games or at any time. Failure to follow this guideline will result in a two (2) game suspension.
8. That you respect any and all property of others as well as the property of the schools. Failure to follow this guideline will result in a one (1) game suspension
9. That there be NO running or bouncing of balls in school hallways going to and from practices, games or water fountains.
10. That you listen to and respect the school custodians at all times.

In accordance with the school districts policy, should you be suspended from school for any reason you are not permitted to participate in practices or games during the length of that suspension.

It is the responsibility of ENYC to insure that you receive equal playing time in all games, that you have one practice and one game per week (both gym availability dependent) and that any injury incurred be addressed immediately.

It is also the responsibility of ENYC to insure that should you have a suggestion, idea, complaint or any issue that you are heard. The process is for you to speak with your coach first, then the division chairperson and then the league board.

Please remember that - at all times - ENYC is a guest of the East Northport-Northport school district and that it is a privilege for ENYC to use the school facilities. This privilege can be taken away by the school district at any time should we not all respect this privilege.
