CLOCK RULES FOR ALL DIVISIONS

10 Minute quarters Running Time. The clock only stops in the last minute of the 2nd and 4th Quarter.
 The Clock runs on all time outs except in the last minute of the 2nd quarter and any time in the 4th quarter.
 There are 2 30 second time outs per half.

- 1) Man to man defense only – no zone defense at any time
- 2) No double teaming or trapping of the player with the ball
- 3) No guarding in the back court. Once the ball has crossed into the front court, a player can guard in the back court on a throw in from out of bounds
- 4) 20 point cap on individual scoring, but if fouled after reaching the cap, player may shoot foul shots
- 5) In man to man defense, you must maintain a distance no greater than 3 feet from the player you are guarding. However, if the offensive player position himself far from the basket, the defensive player need not go further away from the basket than just outside the 3 second lane, so long as he is in a straight line between the basket and the offensive player.
- 6) Teams may not try to “freeze” the ball in the back court. If done, a technical foul will be assessed
- 7) Guarding in the back court will be permitted in the last 2 minutes of the 4th period and overtime
- 8) **All kids MUST play even playing time or game is forfeit and coach will be suspended for next scheduled game.**
- 9) 28.5 Ball Used
- 10) Winning Coach will enter scores on web-site within 24 hours of games end if no ref is assigned to keep score unless league supplies scorekeeper
- 11) 2 Junior Officials
- 12) Home team wears Orange
